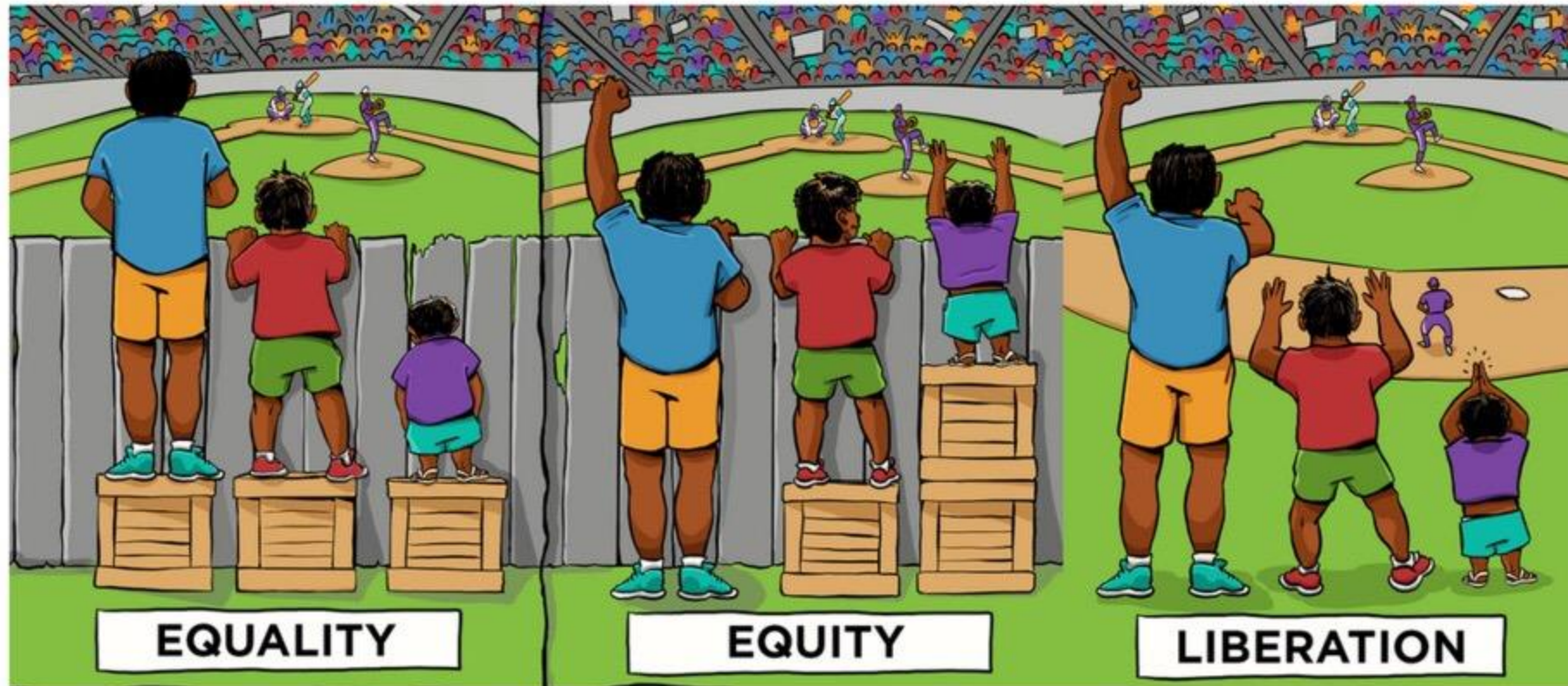

Equality Act (2010) 9 protected characteristics

- It is against the law to discriminate against anyone because of:
 - age
 - being or becoming a transsexual person
 - being married or in a civil partnership
 - being pregnant or on maternity leave
 - disability
 - race including colour, nationality, ethnic or national origin
 - religion, belief or lack of religion/belief
 - sex
 - sexual orientation

Public sector Equality Duty

- ▶ Public bodies have to consider all individuals when carrying out their day-to-day work – in shaping policy, in delivering services and in relation to their own employees.
- ▶ Once we understand this, the rest gets easier!
