Valuing Mental Health Equally with Physical Health


"My family and I have access to services which enable us to maintain both our mental and physical wellbeing."


Why Is It Important?

- Among people under 65, nearly half of all ill health is mental illness
- Yet, only a quarter of all those with mental illness such as depression are in treatment
- We tend to view physical and mental health treatment in separate silos in health services
- People with poor physical health are at higher risk of experiencing mental health problems...and people with poor mental health are more likely to have poor physical

Average life expectancy in England and Wales for people with mental health problems is 60 years behind the national average.¹²





 People with
 mental health problems have worse physical outcomes.

People with mental illness are at increased risk of the top five health killers, including heart disease, stroke, liver and respiratory diseases and some cancers.



Mental illness effect on life expectancy

- 7 to 10 years: in people with depression
- 10 to 15 years: in those with schizophrenia
- Almost 15 years: in those who misuse drugs or alcohol

A Call To:

- Tackle mental health conditions with the same energy and priority as we have physical illnesses.
- Equity of funding, commissioning and training
- End to stigma and prejudice within the NHS which stops people with serious mental health problems getting treated with the same vigour as if they had a physical illness such as diabetes.

If you fall down and break your hip, an ambulance will be with you in eight minutes to give emergency care at the scene before taking you to A&E. If, however, you suffer an acute psychotic episode in the street, you are just as likely to be attended by a police car and taken to a cell.
